Dirty Filters lack gravitational pull

Hot tub filter elements can last up to 3 years, however they need to be chemically cleaned a minimum of every 4 months. A dirty filter will impede the flow of water and cause an error message on your topside. If left untreated, a dirty filter could lead to a popped breaker! Rinsing a filter is not always sufficient to break down all the contaminants that may build on your element. You can purchase spray on cleaners or deep soaking products that leave the filter much cleaner. The proper way to clean a filter requires a 3 stage, 7 day process. Rinse filter, soak in filter cleaner 24-48 hours. Rinse filter, soak in a muriatic acid/water mixture 24-48 hours. Rinse filter, soak in a chlorine/water mixture 24-48 hours. Rinse filter again, let dry 24-48 hours. Any local reputable spa dealer will offer a cleaning service for you.
