Find out whether your spa can weather the winter weather

It is always a good idea to drain, clean and refill your spa at the beginning of the winter season. Ensuring all components are in proper working condition is essential to a repair free season. A few important things to look at would be to make sure all pumps are working, not making any grinding or humming noises. Check all valves for full and proper rotation and ease of motion. Look over filters for cleanliness and wear. If filters are dirty, you may need them to be chemically cleaned and if they are worn or old, you may want to consider replacing them. Improper flow through filter can lead to a number of mechanical problems with other components of your spa. This is also a good time to take additional measures to keep pests from making a new home inside your spa cabinet by sealing up any holes or cracks and using pest control products can help prevent costly repairs.
